

DAYLILIES 2023

Varieties, description and culture.....



Bella Lugosi	\$10.99 / 34" tall / Early season / 6" blooms / Rich purple sunfast petals with a prominent lime green throat. Vigorous with good branching, considered one of the best purples.
Born to Run	\$11.99 / 24" tall / Mid-season / 6" blooms / Wide petaled cranberry-red blooms with a ruffled chartreuse edge and matching throat. A showy tetraploid.
Early Snow	\$9.99 / 29" tall / Early season / 7" blooms / There is finally a good alternative to a nice white daylily other than Joan senior. Giant snow-white blooms with extra thick petals. Ruffled light cream
Earlybird Oriole	\$10.99 / 20" tall / Early-season / 5" blooms / Short-statured with large rounded blooms of two-toned orange with a small lime green throat. An unusually early orange <u>rebloomer</u> .
Garden Show	\$9.99 / 26" tall / Mid-season / 6" blooms / Strongly triangular blooms of diamond dusted mauve purple with a radiant yellow-green throat. A strongly fragrant <u>rebloomer</u> .
King of the Ages	\$12.99 / 38" tall / Mid-season / 6.5" blooms / Tall stems hold multi-colored, ruffled edged flowers of yellows, peach, apricot, red, with white stripes. A fragrant <u>reblooming</u> Proven Winners selection.
Mauna Loa	\$9.99 / 22" tall / Early-mid-season / 5" blooms / Substantially thick petals of solid citrus orange. A good landscape performer with a high bud count.
Moonlit Masquerade	\$9.99 / 26" tall / Early-mid-season / 6" blooms / A strong growing tetraploid of creamy white with a large purple eyezone. <u>Reblooms</u> .
Primal Scream	\$11.99 / 34" tall / Early-Mid season / 8" blooms / Large glimmering tangerine orange with gold-dusted petals that are very ruffled. Not a re-bloomer but blooms for a while in its season.
Purple De Oro	\$9.99 / 20" tall / Early-Midseason / 2.5" blooms / Medium purple flowers over a compact growth habit. Petals have a narrow pie-crust edge, purple veining and a yellow throat. <u>Re-bloomer</u>
Raspberry Eclipse New	\$11.99 / 30" tall / Mid-season / 5.5" blooms / Raspberry purple blooms with a lavender purple band and a bright yellow eye, heavily ruffled petals are edges in a bright yellow picotee edge
Rocket City	\$9.99 / 36" tall / Mid-season / 6" blooms / Large 2-tone orange blooms on strong growing plants.
South Seas	\$9.99 / 23" tall / M-season / 6" blooms / Ruffled, wide petals are saturated in an unusual hot coral pink color. A strong growing rebloomer with a high bud count.
Stella de Oro	\$8.99 / 15" tall / Early season / 2.75" blooms / Solid cheery gold flowers with pie crust edges stay open into the evening. <u>Ever-blooming</u> and still the world's most popular daylily. A Dr. Apps intro
Stephanie Returns	\$10.99 / 18" tall / Early season / 4" blooms / A short <u>ever-bloomer</u> bicolor of a light peach and deeper purple halo and center stripes. Prominent yellow eye. Another Dr. Apps introduction.
Tiger Swirl	\$12.99 / 32" tall / Mid-season / 6.5" blooms / Fragrant bright gold blooms with large maroon eyes. The blooms differ in shape tyhan others, with half of the petals being twisted or curled.
Wineberry Candy	\$9.99 / 22" tall / Early-mid season / 4.75" blooms / Soft pink blooms with a large purple eyezone. A fragrant and long blooming <u>rebloomer</u> .

Daylily Culture: Daylilies should be planted in any well-drained soil with full sun or light shade. Varieties marked "re-bloomers" may send out sporadic scapes after the initial bloom while "ever-bloomers" will usually always have color if planted in clumps of several plants. Best re-bloom is in full sun and consistently moist soil. Any balanced fertilizer applied at half strength works well. Divide the clumps every 3-5 years when vigor and bloom size is noticeably declining. Like some of our other descriptive lists, the average blooming season for that variety is noted so that one may plant with several varieties and have a succession flowers at different times. Daylilies tolerate being planted in the vicinity of black walnut.
